Child Evangelism Fellowship[®] Want to have an exciting, meaningful and fun-filled summer? Consider becoming a Christian Youth in Action or CYIA™ summer missionary.

You would be one of over 3,000 trained CYIA reaching the 50 million children in America.

Why Should you commit to this?

- Unreached children need to hear about Jesus. Many of Beaver County's children under the age of 14 never attend church or Sunday School. Many have never even heard the Gospel.

What will you be doing?

Presenting the Gospel to boys and girls through 5-Day Clubs and VBS programs. 5-Day Clubs are held in churches, backyards, porches, child care centers... wherever there are children.

What requirements must you meet?

- Must be 14 years of age or older*
- Must be a growing Christian
- Have a desire to work with children
- Meet the requirements of the 2 weeks of training
- Be available to teach 5-Day Clubs during July and 2 weeks of Good News Day Camp in August (consideration is made for family vacations)
- Apply by April 1, 2025.
